- 3. **Consultations** with other professionals in your child's life, such as therapists or school counselors, and with other adults who know your child well.
- 4. **Referrals** if necessary, for further testing, tutoring and/or admissions test coaching.
- 5. **Development of recommendations** for appropriate schools or programs.
- **6. Guidance and instruction i**n preparing applications, writing admissions essays, visiting schools, and interviewing.
- Help with arrangements for visiting schools or programs and for admissions testing, including individual administration of the <u>Secondary School Admissions Test (SSAT)</u>.
